Good Morning Istanbul! After you enjoy your breakfast at the hotel, you will begin a full-day sightseeing tour of Istanbul.

Istanbul is a major city in Turkey that straddles Europe

and Asia across the Bosphorus Strait. Its Old City reflects the cultural influences of the many empires that once ruled here.

In the Sultanahmet district, the open-air, Roman-era Hippodrome was for centuries the site of chariot races, and Egyptian obelisks also remain. The iconic Byzantine Hagia Sophia features a soaring 6th-century dome and rare Christian mosaics.

You will first visit Topkapi Palace (harem section is optional), ancient Roman Hippodrome, Hagia Sophia. The Topkap? Palace, or the Seraglio, is a large museum in the east of the Faith district of Istanbul in Turkey.

In the 15th and 16th centuries, it served as the main residence and administrative headquarters of the Ottoman sultans.

Continue your journey to Sultanahmet tour with the Blue Mosque and stop at the Grand Covered Bazaar and will have free time to discover 4000 tiny shops in the passageways of the world's largest covered bazaar.

Many of the city's most famous buildings are in Sultanahmet, the center of old Istanbul. Once a church, then a mosque, and now a museum, the Hagia Sophia displays Byzantine mosaics.

Six minarets mark the Blue Mosque, while walkways wind underground at the Basilica Cistern, which once supplied



water to lavish Topkap? Palace nearby. Several museums border tranquil Gülhane Park, with its Bosphorus views.

End your day with an overnight stay in Istanbul.

You will enjoy your delicious breakfast at the hotel. Get

ready for a quick flight in the morning to Izmir.

Izmir is a city on Turkey's Aegean coast. Known as Smyrna in antiquity, it was founded by the Greeks, taken over by the Romans, and rebuilt by Alexander the Great before becoming part of the Ottoman Empire in the 15th century.

Today, its expansive archaeological sites include the Roman Agora of Smyrna, now an open-air museum. The hilltop Kadifekale, or Velvet Castle, built during Alexander's reign, overlooks the city.

From there, our representative will drive you to Ephesus, one of the "Seven Churches of Revelation".

The city of Ephesus was famed for the nearby Temple of Artemis (completed around 550 BC), one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Among many other monumental buildings is the Library of Celsus, and a theatre capable of holding 25,000 spectators.

Ephesus was one of the seven churches of Asia that are cited in the Book of Revelation. The Gospel of John may have been written here. The city was the site of several 5th-century Christian Councils (see Council of Ephesus).

Here, you will visit St. John' Basilica, which stands over the believed burial site of John the Apostle. It was modeled



after the now lost Church of the Holy Apostles in Constantinople.

Continue your journey to the last home of Mary at Mount SoElmissos.

After you enjoy your lunch in a local restaurant, you will continue your drive to Laodicea, a crossroads of the ancient world.

You will then make your way to Pamukkale where you will be staying overnight.

The Acropolis, which means Upper Town, has the most important remains of Pergamon. The acropolis has been largely founded on a hill is one of the unique masterpieces of the old settlements as a cut-mountain town due to the lack of the natural plateau.

The places where the temples, palaces, library, theatre, and other necessary edifices have been built, on the big terraces from the beginning of the first settlement.

Have your delightful lunch at a local restaurant.

Afterward, you will then take a beautiful drive to Smyrna (Izmir). The church of Smyrna was the recipient of a letter from Paul praising the early believers for their faithfulness.

You will be visiting Saint Polycarp Church, a Catholic church in ?zmir, Turkey. Its patron saint is Polycarp and a short informational tour of the city.




