

Start your day with a visit to the iconic landmark of the area, the Falls. The Victoria Falls, now in its 150 millionth year, reaches its zenith in about May each year. It's a truly aweinspiring experience - the sight, the sound, the smell; the

humbling feeling that here indeed is nature's supreme masterpiece. Your qualified guide may take you past the 'Big Tree' for photographs, then onwards through the Rainforest for a brief history of the Falls themselves, providing details on other points of interest and the area's flora, fauna, bird and wildlife. No photograph can begin to depict the reality of the Victoria Falls...and nothing prepares you for your first sight.

Round off a magical day with a luxury sunset cruise on the Zambezi Royal. This is a wonderful way to view the scenery of the river, accompanied by gourmet snacks, imported wines and spirits, and superb service. Spectacular African sunsets, flocks of birds skimming the waterline and a variety of game - hippo, crocodiles and elephant - offer great photo opportunities and a relaxing experience.

Following a quick, but lovely start in Zimbabwe, you will check out of the Batonka Guest Lodge this morning in time for your transfer across the border to Kasane where you will go through custom formalities before continuing to your first safari camp in Chobe National Park. (This service is on a

group basis.)

Welcome to Botswana! Once you have settled in, you can start enjoying the activities included in your stay at Chobe Game Lodge!

Chobe National Park

Chobe National Park features one of the largest concentrations of game in all of Africa. Located in Northern Botswana, it was the country's first National Park and is now the third largest in size and most biologically diverse. For these reasons, Chobe is an essential bucket list destination, while on safari in Botswana. The Chobe floodplains and Chobe River provide a sensitive ecosystem, where the wildlife concentrate during the dry season. It is not uncommon to see between 500 and 5,000 elephants on these floodplains at one time! Between the combination of wildlife, bird life and reptiles that are scattered along the banks of the Chobe River, this National Park is a photographer's dream.



Days 4 - 5: Chobe National Park

Lodge Activities

Chobe Game Lodge offers an exciting variety of land or water-based activities in the Chobe National Park. Early morning and late afternoon game drives are conducted by

expert guides in open-sided 4x4 vehicles, to ensure maximum visibility of the park's spectacular scenery and abundant wildlife. Meanwhile, riverside game viewing may be done from small and highly maneuverable boats, perfect for morning or sunset cruises. Chobe's diverse wildlife roams in abundance and is even home to the largest concentration of elephant in Africa. During the dry season, these large herds, as well as herds of buffalo, congregate on the fertile flood plains along the Chobe River to drink, bathe and play. There are frequent sightings of lion, African wild dog, puku, red lechwe, sable, giraffe and roan antelope as well.

Between safari activities, cool off in the pool or keep an eye out for elephants, hippos and other wildlife that are regularly seen from the lodge. Being the only lodge in the reserve, you will have the benefit of exclusivity before the park gates open to the public. Your fully inclusive stay covers all meals, local brand drinks, two scheduled safari activities daily, National Park fees and laundry. Premium imported wines, champagnes and spirits are excluded. (This service is on a group basis.)

Day 6: Chobe National Park - Moremi

Today your adventure continues to the Moremi Game Reserve. From Chobe Game Lodge, you will be transferred to the Kasane Airport in good time for your charter flight to the Xakanaxa Airstrip. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to Camp Moremi. (*This service is on a group basis.*)

Moremi Game Reserve

Moremi Game Reserve is situated in the eastern corner of the Okavango Delta. The Moremi Game Reserve is all about searching for big game, where the habitats are as diverse as the wildlife itself. Water-adapted antelopes and wary-eyed buffaloes spill out into floodplains, behind towering woodlands where leopards hide on the high branches. Dead trees cast silhouettes over elephant-filled savannas a stone's throw from papyrus-fringed channels stretching out to the delta beyond. As Moremi Game Reserve is bound by national park rules, activities here are limited to game drives during hours of daylight with no off-roading, and boat cruises on the permanent channels.



Days 7 - 8: Moremi Wednesday Jan 29, 2020-Thursday Jan 30, 2020

Camp Activities

Camp activities include a choice of morning and afternoon game drives throughout the many different ecosystems that the Moremi Game Reserve has to offer or the possibility to explore the Xakanaxa Lagoon and its surrounding channels

by boat. This blend of activities allows for access to incredible landscapes, impressive wildlife as well as the opportunity to enjoy the picturesque waters of the Okavango Delta.

The team of experienced professional guides will introduce you to a whole new world of wildlife; watch a Leopard stretched out lazily in the branches of a Mopane tree, herds of Elephant grazing under a canopy of green or a pride of Lions camouflaged in the long grass. Moremi Game Reserve's incredible wetlands support a vast number of antelope, including Impala, Kudu, and Waterbuck. Birdlife is prolific and the majestic Fish Eagle and vivid Malachite Kingfisher are frequently seen and even the rare Pel's Fishing Owl makes an occasional appearance, to the delight of guides and guests alike. (This service is on a group basis.)



Day 9: Moremi - Okavango Delta

Okavango Delta

The Okavango Delta is one of the world's largest inland deltas situated in the middle of the largest stretch of continuous sand in the world - the Kalahari basin. This oasis in the middle of the desert is a rich yet fragile ecosystem, providing a life source for an incredible variety of wildlife. A wealth of species have adapted to the contrasting conditions created by living in the harsh Kalahari desert which is transformed annually with the arrival of the delta flood waters originating in Angola.



Day 10: Okavango Delta

Camp Activities

Water-based activities are conducted by experienced professional guides who will expertly navigate you through the many meandering, reed-lined waterways. Roam the vast expanses of water from the comfort of a modern motorboat

or explore the intricacies of the Okavango Delta the quiet old-fashioned way, in the traditional mokoro (dugout canoe).

For those wanting to get a little closer to nature, guided bush walks are conducted on a number of the nearby islands, offering an opportunity to track some of the larger land-based species that inhabit this water wilderness. Birding opportunities are outstanding and anglers may put their skill against bream and tiger fish. Camp Okavango is a waterbased camp and game-drive activities, using safari vehicles, are not possible. (This service is on a group basis.)



Day 11: Okavango Delta - Maun Departure

mini bar and tea and coffee stations. The en-suite facilities include a bath and an inside and outside shower, so that you can shower under the starry skies of Zimbabwe!



Chobe Game Lodge

Chobe Game Lodge is the only permanent lodge situated within the boundaries of Chobe National Park. Built along the riverbanks with spectacular views of the Chobe River and the surrounding floodplains, this well established lodge is a prime venue to explore the wonders of Chobe National Park. You will be taken care of by the hospitable and friendly staff of the lodge, in a relaxed and luxurious environment in tune with a timeless Africa. Chobe Game Lodge features 48 rooms, which are river facing with air conditioning and overhead fans, a complimentary mini bar, en-suite bathrooms and tea and coffee making facilities. All rooms have their own private terrace as well.

Camp Xakanaxa

Situated in one of the most beautiful parts of the Okavango Delta in the heart of the Moremi Wildlife Reserve, which is rated as being one of the finest game viewing areas in Africa, Xakanaxa is a place of secret pools, tall forests, open grasslands and open lagoons. Virtually every corner reveals a scene of exquisite beauty - to the north and west of the camp are the permanent lagoons and waterways of the Okavango, and to the south and east are the dry woodlands. Xakanaxa is unusual in the Moremi in offering both land and water activities all year round given the permanent channels close to the lodge. Xakanaxa Camp offers 13 Meru-style luxury tents built on elevated wooden platforms with en-



suite facilities. Each tent is well furnished with twin or double beds and en-suite facilities with shower, hand basin and toilet. The tents are situated on the edge of the lagoon and from their private viewing deck, with comfortable loungers, you look out over the waterways. The camp, with its eclectic mix of furnishings from all over Africa, has a dining room and lounge/bar area which are cantilevered over the Xakanaxa lagoon, as well as a sundeck and plunge pool all slightly raised on wooden platforms with spectacular views. At night the camp looks stunning as it is lit by dozens of paraffin lamps and candles.

To ensure a peaceful and genuine safari experience, Camp Okavango accommodates just twenty-four guests.
