

Day 10: OCT 8, WED - EDFU - LUXOR / NILE CRUISE

- Enjoy your breakfast on board this morning.
- In the morning, you will visit the **Edfu Temple**, a well-preserved temple dedicated to the falcon god Horus. After exploring this ancient site, you'll return to the cruise ship to continue your journey.
- Enjoy lunch on board followed by an afternoon tea as the cruise sails towards Luxor via Esna. Relax and take in the scenery along the Nile River.
- Upon arrival at Luxor's East Bank, you will meet your guide in the lobby and be transferred to visit
 the Karnak and Luxor Temples. These impressive temples are among the largest and most
 significant religious complexes in ancient Egypt, showcasing magnificent architecture and rich
 history.
- After completing your tour, return to the cruise ship to enjoy dinner on board. Later in the evening, experience a Belly Dance Show, adding to the cultural richness of your Nile cruise experience.
- Overnight accommodation will be on board the cruise ship in Luxor, allowing you to rest and prepare for the next day's adventures.



Day 11: OCT 9, WED - LUXOR TO CAIRO / CRUISE DISEMBARKATION

- After breakfast, you'll gather your belongings and disembark from the cruise ship.
- Your first stop will be the Valley of the Kings, where you'll explore three tombs of ancient Egyptian pharaohs. Next, proceed to visit the impressive Queen Hatshepsut Temple, a striking example of ancient Egyptian architecture nestled against the cliffs of Deir el-Bahari.
- You'll then visit the nearby Habu Temple of Ramses III, known for its well-preserved reliefs and vibrant colors depicting ancient Egyptian life and mythology. Finally, you'll see the Colossi of Memnon, towering statues that once guarded the entrance to Amenhotep III's mortuary temple.
- After you explore Luxor's West Bank, you'll be transferred to the airport for your late afternoon
 flight back to Cairo.(included) Upon arrival at Cairo International Airport, you'll clear immigration
 and customs with assistance from our representative. They will then escort you to your hotel in
 Cairo for an evening of leisure and an overnight stay, allowing you to relax and reflect on your
 journey through ancient Egypt.

Day 12: OCT 10, WED - ALEXANDRIA

- After you enjoy your delightful Breakfast, your Egyptologist Guide & driver will pick you up from your hotel and drive for almost 3 hours to the Mediterranean coastal city of Alexandria
- Early Christian roots in Alexandria are deeply significant, tracing back to Saint Mark, who founded the Christian church in Egypt around the mid-first century A.D.
- Today, the majority of Egyptian Christians belong to the Coptic Orthodox Church of Alexandria, an
 ancient Oriental Orthodox Church established by Saint Mark. By A.D. 300, Alexandria had developed
 into a prominent center of Christianity, with the church being led by the Pope of Alexandria and
 Patriarch of All Africa, currently Pope Tawadros II
- Your Tour of Alexandria includes:
- Alexandria's historical significance extends to its architectural wonders, such as the catacombs of Kom El-Shuqqafa, a necropolis dating back to the 2nd century AD blending Egyptian, Greek, and Roman influences.
- Pompey's Pillar, dedicated to the Greco-Egyptian deity Serapis, and the Roman amphitheater
 further showcase the city's rich ancient heritage. The 15th-century Citadel of Qaitbay, built on the
 site of the ancient Lighthouse of Alexandria, provides a glimpse into the city's defensive prowess.
- Conclude your day with a visit to the modern Alexandria Library, a striking modern design contrasting with Egypt's ancient architecture. Enjoy free time to explore the library (extra cost on spot) before returning to your hotel in Cairo.
- Dinner at your leisure.

Day 1: SEPT 29, MON - USA DEPARTURE

Today, you will embark on your flight from the USA to Cairo, Egypt.

Day 2: SEPT 30, TUE - CAIRO

- Upon arrival, you will be met by our representative who will assist you with your transfer to the hotel. Check-in and settle into your room, allowing yourself time to rest and recover from your journey.
- Hotel: Hilton Pyramids Golf (or similar).



Day 3: OCT 1, WED - CAIRO/PYRAMIDS/SPHINX CITY TOUR

Meals: B, L, D

- Begin your day with a delightful **breakfast** at the hotel. Enjoy a leisurely morning with a late start at **11 am**.
- Meet your expert Egyptologist guide to start your adventure by visiting one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World: the 3 Pyramids of Giza.
- First, explore the Great Pyramid of Cheops, the oldest and largest of the three pyramids in the Giza Necropolis, built in the 3rd dynasty around 2690 B.C. as a tomb for the Egyptian Pharaoh Khufu.
- Then, see the Pyramid of Chechen, and finally, marvel at the majestic Great Sphinx, the largest single-block sculpture in the world, located at the base of the Pyramid of Chechen. Enjoy the unique opportunity to ride a camel by the Pyramids, included in your tour.
- Around 2 pm, savor a late lunch at a local restaurant. (included).
- After lunch, visit to the famous **Egyptian Museum**, where your guide will provide you with a vivid and colorful insight into Egypt's five thousand years of fascinating history.
- Journey next to Old Cairo and begin with the **Hanging Church**, Cairo's most famous Coptic church, first built in the 3rd or 4th century AD.
- Proceed to the Church of St. Sergius, a 5th-century Coptic church built on the cave where the Holy Family is believed to have stayed, regarded by visitors as a source of blessing.
- Conclude your day by exploring the spices and silks in the medieval bazaar of Khan el-Khalili, one of the largest bazaars in the Middle East and the most famous in North Africa.
- Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant during your tour (included).
- Hotel: Hilton Pyramids Golf (or similar).

Day 4: OCT 2, THU - MEMPHIS/SAQQARA/ DAHSHUR/CAIRO

- After enjoying a delicious breakfast at the hotel, you will meet your guide to begin your day's adventure.
- Your first destination will be Memphis, the early capital of Egypt, where you'll explore the Step
 Pyramid and Tombs of Saqqara, along with the Imhotep Museum and Dashur, featuring the
 Bent Pyramid.
- Moses would of visited the ancient sites of Memphis, Saqqara, and Dahshur during his lifetime.
 Memphis was the first capital city of Egypt and is located near present-day Cairo. It served as an important political and cultural center during various periods of ancient Egyptian history.
- You'll delight in a delightful lunch at a local restaurant, included in your tour.
- Afterward, return to your hotel in Cairo to relax and refresh.
- Enjoy a dinner at the hotel, also included, and the evening is yours to spend at leisure.

Day 5: OCT 3, FRI - SINAI DESERT/MORAH BY THE RED SEA/ELIM/REPHIDIM Meals: B, L,

- After enjoying a delightful breakfast, you will embark on a journey by private air-conditioned bus towards St. Catherine, traversing underneath the Suez Canal to the west branch of the Red Sea
- The drive through the Sinai Peninsula and the biblical Land of Goshen to the Mount Sinai area spans approximately 233 miles and takes about 6 hours.
- Along the way, you will pass by **Marah by the Red Sea**, where the desert springs once provided water that was bitter (Exodus 15:22-16:35) to the children of Israel. (stop contingent upon if police escort has left).
- Lunch in route (included).

- Continuing onward, you will visit Alim, a desert oasis, and proceed to Wadi Feiran (Rephidim)
 (Exodus 17, 18), the desert valley where the children of Israel encountered the Amalekites. Next,
 you will journey to Mount Serbal, (Exodus 17:11-13) traditionally considered the site where Moses
 held his arms up for victory.
- Continuing inland, you will head towards the granite mountains of **Mount Sinai** and **Wadi El Raha**.
- Check in to the hotel in time for dinner.
- Hotel: Morgan Land Hotel.

Day 6: OCT 4, SAT - CLIMB UP MT. SINAI JABEL MUSA

Meals: B. L. D

- Early in the morning, you'll depart for a sunrise climb of **Mount Sinai**, also known as **Jabel Musa**. A **camel ride will assist you two-thirds** of the way up the mountain, offering views of the breathtaking sunrise over the valley.
- After witnessing the sunrise, you will descend the mountain and be transferred back to your hotel.
 Enjoy a hearty breakfast at the hotel.
- Next, you'll embark on a tour of St. Catherine Monastery, was constructed between 527 and 565
 A.C. by the Roman Emperor Justinian.
- Continuing your journey, you'll head towards **Sharm el-Sheikh**, stopping at the Land Bridge Crossing Site on the Red Sea (Exodus 14).
- Afterward, take some time to explore the village of Sharm el-Sheikh before returning to the hotel for dinner, which is included.
- Hotel: Morgan Land Hotel



Day 7: OCT 5, SUN - SINAI TO CAIRO TO ASWAN

Meals: B. I

- After enjoying breakfast at your hotel, prepare to check out and get ready for your bus departure back to Cairo.
- You'll have lunch at a local restaurant en route to the airport.
- Arrive at the airport for your flight check-in. You will have dinner on your own at the airport before boarding your flight around 7:45 pm, arriving in Aswan at approximately 9:05 pm.(flight included)
- Upon arrival at Aswan Airport, one of our representatives will meet you and transfer you to your hotel. Check-in at the hotel in Aswan, where the remainder of the evening is free at your leisure.

Day 8: OCT 6, MON - ASWAN/ HIGH DAM/PHILAE/ NILE CRUISE

Meals: B, L, D

- Enjoy a delicious breakfast at your hotel, and gather all your belongings as you prepare to check out. Your guide will meet you in the lobby to commence your exploration of Aswan's highlights, including the Aswan High Dam, Philae Temple, and the unfinished Obelisk.
- After your sightseeing tour, you will be transferred to embark on your Nile Cruise for a luxurious 4day, 3-night journey with all-inclusive meals. Upon boarding, take some time to settle in and relax, enjoying lunch on board.
- In the late afternoon, your first visit will be to a **Nubian Village**, where you will immerse yourself in the vibrant river life and culture of these hospitable people. The rest of the afternoon is yours to enjoy at leisure on board the cruise ship.
- Overnight accommodations will be in Aswan aboard the River Cruise.



Day 9: OCT 7, TUE - ABU SIMBEL- KOM OMBO - EDFU / NILE CRUISE

- You will start your day with an early 4:30 am pick-up to visit the Abu Simbel Temple. You will
 experience the sunrise over the Sarah dessert. You will be provided a Breakfast box to go.
- This historic site consists of two massive rock-cut temples located in the village of Abu Simbel, Upper Egypt, near the Sudanese border. Built by Pharaoh Ramses II (1303 – 1213 BCE), the temples stand proudly on the western bank of Lake Nasser.
- After your exploration of Abu Simbel, you'll be transferred back to your cruise ship to continue your journey.
- Enjoy **lunch on board** as the ship sets sail for its next destination.
- In the afternoon, the cruise will sail towards **Kom Ombo Temple**. Your guide will gather you in the lobby to disembark and visit this unique **Ptolemaic double temple**, constructed between 180-47 BC. Dedicated to the deities **Sobek and Horus**, **Kom Ombo Temple** features fascinating hieroglyphs depicting calendars with figures for the days of the month and the inundation season.
- Return to the cruise ship in the evening and enjoy dinner on board, followed by an Oriental Show.
 The cruise will then set sail to Edfu for your overnight stay on board.
