Day 1: OCT 4TH - SUNDAY - DEPART USA

Your incredible adventure to Israel begins today as you depart from the USA. You will board an overnight international flight. This journey offers



Day 2: OCT 5TH - MONDAY - ARRIVAL TO ISRAEL

Welcome to Tel Aviv! Upon landing at Ben Gurion Airport (TLV), you will be met by a "Smile Service" representative for a seamless and expedited arrival. Your guide will meet you and the group after baggage claim and will immediately whisk you away for a short tour of the city. We will explore the ancient cobblestone streets of Old Jaffa Port, a place rich with history and beautiful sea views.

Afterward, you'll be transferred to the Tal Hotel to check in and freshen up. At 19:00, we'll all meet for a welcome dinner at the hotel, a perfect way to end your first day in Israel. Enjoy a restful overnight stay at the Tal Hotel (or similar). Tel Aviv.

Day 3: OCT 6TH -TUESDAY - THE MEDITERRANEAN COAST

After breakfast at 7:00 am, check out of the hotel. Depart at 7:30 am for a day of discovery. Our first stop is the ancient Roman city of Caesarea, where you'll explore Herod's magnificent ruins, including the Roman theater and aqueduct.

Next, we will travel to Mount Carmel, the site where the Prophet Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal. From there, we will visit Tel Megiddo, known as the biblical site of Armageddon, to see its historic excavations.

Lunch is on your own at 13:00.

In the afternoon, at 15:30, we will experience Nazareth Village, a recreation of life in the time of Jesus. Our day concludes with check-in at the Ramada Oliver Nazareth (or similar). Dinner will be served at the hotel at 19:00, followed by a well-deserved overnight stay.





Day 4: OCT 7TH - WEDNESDAY - THE SEA OF GALILEE

After breakfast, depart at 8:00 am for a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee with a musical performance by Dani Carmel. We will then visit the First-Century Boat Museum at Ginnosar.

Next, we explore Capernaum, the town of Jesus. At 13:00, a delicious St. Peter's Fish lunch is included. The afternoon continues with a visit to Tabgha, the site of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes, and the ancient city of Magdala.

Our final stop is a baptism site on the Jordan River.

Return to the Ramada Oliver Nazareth (or similar) for dinner at 19:00 and an overnight stay.

Day 5: OCT 8TH -THURSDAY - GOLAN HEIGHTS - AMMAN

After breakfast, we check out and head to the Golan Heights. Our stops include Kursi, the site of a biblical miracle, and Caesarea Philippi, where Peter confessed his faith. We'll then explore Tel Dan, an ancient biblical city, and take in panoramic views from Mount Bental, overlooking the borders of Syria and Lebanon.

We will then drive to the Sheikh Hussein Bridge to cross into Jordan. If time allows, we will visit Mount Nebo.

Our day concludes with dinner and an overnight stay at the Hilton Hotel Dead Sea (or similar) on the Jordan side.

Day 6: OCT 9TH - FRIDAY - DEAD SEA - PETRA

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast and some free time this morning to float in the mineral-rich waters of the Dead Sea.

Afterward, we will check out and drive to Madaba, the "City of Mosaics," to see the ancient mosaic map of the Holy Land.

We then continue our scenic drive to Petra. Upon arrival, check in to the Petra MOON Hotel (or similar) for dinner and an overnight stay, preparing for a full day of exploration tomorrow.

Day 7: OCT 10TH - SATURDAY - PETRA

After breakfast, we will embark on a full-day tour of the ancient "Rose City" of Petra. The tour includes a walk through the magnificent Siq to the iconic Treasury (Al-Khazneh), as well as visits to the Street of Facades, the Roman Theater, and the Royal Tombs.

A delicious lunch will be provided on-site (included). The afternoon is reserved for free time to explore Petra at your own pace.

The day concludes with dinner and an overnight stay at the Petra MOON Hotel (or similar).





Day 8: OCT 11TH - SUNDAY - MASADA - JERUSALEM

After breakfast, we will drive to the Arava Border to cross back into Israel. Our first stop is Timna Park to visit the replica of the Tabernacle.

Next, we travel to Masada, ascending and descending via cable car to explore the fortress and its incredible history. If time allows, we'll stop at Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found.

Finally, we drive to Jerusalem. We will check in at the Olive Tree Hotel (or similar) for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 9: OCT 12TH - MONDAY - OLD CITY JERUSALEM

After breakfast, our day is dedicated to a tour of the Old City of Jerusalem. We'll begin with a panoramic view from the Mount of Olives.

Next, we will enter the Old City to visit the Church of All Nations and proceed to Mount Zion to see the Tomb of King David and the Room of the Last Supper. We'll walk through the ancient Cardo, see the Temple Mount and the Western Wall, and walk the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre.

The tour includes a walk through the bustling Arab bazaar. Our final stop is the Garden Tomb.





After breakfast, we will visit a model of ancient Jerusalem. Next, we will pay our respects at Yad Vashem, Israel's Holocaust memorial, and walk the Street of the Righteous Among the Nations.

We then visit Ein Karem, the birthplace of John the Baptist. Our tour continues to Bethlehem to see the Church of the Nativity and Manger Square.

The trip concludes with a farewell dinner in Bethlehem before transferring to the airport for your departure flight. (depending upon flight details, this will be updated)

Day 11: OCT 14 - WEDNESDAY - DEPARTURE

Today marks the conclusion of your spiritual and historical journey through Israel and Jordan. You will transfer to Ben Gurion Airport (TLV) for your flight home, filled with incredible memories and a deeper connection to the Holy Land.

Thank you for visiting Mission Travel Faith Tours website (the "Website") we are honored. The terms "MTT," "we" and "our" refers to Mission Travel Tours Inc., a Florida corporation, and a DMC tour operator registered with the State of Florida as a Seller of Travel Registration no. ST42780, which offers and operates along with our affiliate partners all trips listed herein.

1. REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

A deposit of \$500 per person is required at the time of booking for all tours, including corporate incentive tours, leisure destination tours, private group tours, wedding destinations, educations and university tours. For special events such as corporate incentive tours, wedding destinations, education and university tours an additional deposit could be recommended. A deposit of \$750 per person will be necessary to secure your booking on all cruise tours. We accept payments via credit card, wire transfer, or money order

The balance for your trip is due 90 days prior to departure. If your reservation is made within 90 days of departure, the entire trip cost must be paid upon confirmation. To finalize your reservation, you must sign a Traveler Information Form and an Acknowledgement of Risk, Release, and Indemnity form before your travel date. These documents, which include additional terms and conditions of travel, as well as limitations of our obligations to you, will be sent to you in your booking confirmation email.

CONFIRMATION PACKAGE

Once your payment is received for your travel and or special event tour is confirmed, we will send you a detailed confirmation package. This will include information on what to bring, how to prepare for your trip, travel directions, a detailed itinerary, pre- and post-tour hotel information, and Mission Travel Tours policies.

2. CANCELLATION

All cancellations of confirmed reservations are subject to \$500 per person administrative fee. Additionally, clients are subject to any cancellation fees assessed by the purveyors of services including hotels, rail, or airlines used in the itinerary. Cancellations 90 days or more prior to departure will receive a full refund minus the \$500 per person administrative fee. 60-89 days will be subject to loss of deposit (30% trip price). 30-59 days will be subject to loss of 50% of tour price. 29 days or less will be subject to 100% of tour price.

3. INSURANCE

We recommend in all Deposit and Final Confirmation Packages travel insurance that offers you options to cover baggage, accident/ life, and/or trip cancellation. Trip cancellation insurance reimburses you for non-refundable air and land costs if you have to cancel a trip due to personal or family illness or accident. Please keep in mind that the insurance companies make additional benefits available to you if you take out the insurance within 15° days of making your reservation with us.

4. PASSPORTS AND VISAS

The visa and passport requirements of countries to which we travel vary according to the nationality of each traveler and may change at any time for reasons beyond our control. Although we endeavor to provide you with accurate information about these requirements it remains the responsibility of each traveler to verify that he or she has the appropriate travel documents for his or her nationality. MTT is not liable for any expenses or costs arising from any traveler being prohibited from entering a country scheduled to be visited on a trip.

Quoted airfare rates are subject to change until paid in full. Assigned seating may be limited and may not be available on every flight or departure date. 6. INSTANT PURCHASE NON-REFUNDABLE AIRFARE:

Instant purchase non-refundable airfare requires full payment at the time of booking. Once a ticket is issued, there can be no fluctuation in price due to an increase in government taxes or in airline fuel surcharges. MTT will not accept any liability for any claims that are not received within 30 days of the termination of your travel experience. ELIGIBILITY

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE
