Day 1: ISTANBUL

Welcome to the beautiful City of Istanbul, the Country of Turkey!

You will arrive at the airport in Istanbul, and one of our representatives will welcome you and provide you with a brief introduction.

You will then be transferred to Deluxe Golden Horn Istanbul-Deluxe Double Room (or similar) for an overnight stay in Istanbul.

Day 3: HATAY / TARSUS / IZMIR

You will enjoy your delicious breakfast at the hotel. You'll be headed to Tarsus this morning for app 3 hr drive. Here you will be visiting the Church of St. Paul, a former Greek Orthodox church in Tarsus.

You will also see St. Peters well.

You'll return to Adan Airport for a quick flight at 10:35 pm to Izmir - Arrival 00:05

Upon arrival in Izmir, you will be met by our representative and transported to your hotel for time at your leisure.

Day 2: ISTANBUL TO ANTIOCH

Good Morning Istanbul! After you enjoy your breakfast at the hotel, you will be picked up and transferred to the airport for a domestic flight to Adana

Upon arrival in Adana, you will be met by one of our representatives and driven to Antioch (Antakya) or modern-day Hatay (apx 2.5 hr drive)

Here you will visit St. Peter's Grotto and the magnificent mosaic museum. The Church of Saint Peter is composed of a cave carved into the mountainside on Mount Starius with a depth of 13 m, a width of 9.5 m, and a height of 7 m. This cave is one of Christianity's oldest churches.

The Hatay Archaeology Museum is the archaeology museum of Antakya, Turkey. It is known for its extensive collection of Roman and Byzantine Era mosaics.

End your day with an overnight stay in Hotel (or similar).

Day 4: SMYRNA / EPHESUS

Rise and shine you will be on the move! After you relish your breakfast in the morning, you will visit St. Polycarp Church in Izmir (Smyrna), one of the oldest standing churches in Izmir.

Afterwards, you will proceed to visit the Agora & Clock Tower of Smyrna, one of the most emblematic landmarks of Izmir, this imposing clock tower stands to guard the antiquated expanse of Konak Square.

Drive (app. 1,5 hours) to visit Ephesus, a prosperous and highly cultured trade centre, home of the Temple of Artemis, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Continue to visit the House of the Virgin Mary. It is said that the Virgin Mary had spent her last days in the vicinity of Ephesus.

End your day with an overnight stay at the hotel.



After your hearty breakfast, you will drive (approx 1.5 Hours) to Philadelphia, the youngest of the "Seven Churches of Revelation", in here you will visit the still-standing remains of the early church and the city walls.

You will drive (approx 1 Hour) to Sardis known biblically as the home of the church that received the fifth of letters to the seven churches in Revelation, Sardis was the capital of the Lydian. Continue your drive (approx. 1 Hour) to the remains of the Church of Thyatira.

Drive to the hotel to end your day and rest overnight.





Day 5: PERGAMON / PERGAMON / SMYRNA / KUSADASI

YRelish your early morning breakfast at the hotel. Today, you will visit the Acropolis of Pergamon, a rich and powerful ancient Greek city in Mysia. Visit Red Church (former Isis Temple).

Visit the Asklepion of Pergamon. Asclepius watches over the ruins of the Asklepion, a healing complex located at the base of the Pergamum acropolis.

Head back again to Izmir to catch your flight (app 1.5 hours) to Istanbul. Upon arrival at the airport, you will be transferred to your hotel to rest.

Booking Terms

Thank you for visiting Mission Travel Faith Tours website (the "Website") we are honored. The terms "MTT," "we" and "our" refers to Mission Travel Tours Inc., a Florida corporation, and a DMC tour operator registered with the State of Florida as a Seller of Travel Registration no. ST42780, which offers and operates along with our affiliate partners all trips listed herein.

1. REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

A deposit of \$350 per person is required at the time of booking. We accept payment via credit card, wire transfer, or money order for your deposit. The balance is due 90 days prior to departure. If your reservation is made within 90 days of departure, the entire cost of the trip must be paid at the time of confirmation. To complete your reservation, you must sign a Traveler Information Form and an Acknowledgement of Risk, Release and Indemnity, prior to your date of travel with us. These will be sent to you in your booking confirmation email. These forms include additional terms and conditions of travel, including limitations of our obligations to you.

CONFIRMATION PACKAGE

Once payment is received and travel is confirmed we will send you detailed information on what to bring, how to prepare for your trip, travel directions, detailed itinerary, pre-and post-tour hotel information and Mission Travel Tours policies.

2. CANCELLATION

All cancellations of confirmed reservations are subject to a \$350 per person administrative fee. Additionally, clients are subject to any cancellation fees assessed by the purveyors of services including hotels, rail, or airlines used in the itinerary. Cancellations 90 days or more prior to departure will receive a full refund minus the \$350 per person administrative fee. 60-89 days will be subject to loss of deposit (30% trip price). 30-59 days will be subject to loss of 50% of tour price. 29 days or less will be subject to 100% of tour price.

3. INSURANCE

We recommend in all Deposit and Final Confirmation Packages travel insurance that offers you options to cover baggage, accident/ life, and/or trip cancellation. Trip cancellation insurance reimburses you for non-refundable air and land costs if you have to cancel a trip due to personal or family illness or accident. The insurance that we recommend also provides coverage for all preexisting conditions if you complete your insurance form and postmark it within seven calendar days of our receipt of your deposit. We highly recommend that you obtain this insurance.

We suggest Travel Guard International; there are two ways to purchase your insurance from Travel Guard. The fastest and easiest way is to purchase your insurance on-line by clicking the Travel Guard link after you have completed your reservation with Mission Travel Tours. The link will take you directly to the Travel Guard website, where in minutes you can be insured in full for your trip with us. Travel Guard will send you an insurance certificate. If you prefer for us to help you with this let us know and we can provide a Travel Guard application. Please

keep in mind that Travel Guard makes additional benefits available to you if you take out the insurance within 15' days of making your reservation with us.

4. PASSPORTS AND VISAS

5. BAGGAGE
