Day 1: USA DEPARTURE

Board your international flight to London, England.

Baggage Allowance: Each traveler is permitted one checked luggage bag and one soft carry-on item, such as a backpack.



Day 2: LONDON ARRIVAL (D)

Arrive in London at approximately 11:42 AM.

You will be met by a local representative for a warm welcome and private transfer to your hotel by coach.

Check into the hotel and the Rest of the day at leisure – we will give you an Oyster card valid for the TUBE, public transport in zones 1 & 2, so you can explore the city on your own.

Dinner at your hotel or local restaurant.

Overnight stay: London

Hotel: Crowne Plaza Kings Cross or SIMILAR



Day 3: DISCOVER LONDON (B,L,D)

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before heading out on a full-day guided tour of London's highlights, including:

A Walking tour- walking tour where you will see the outside of Buckingham Palace, Big Ben, and the Houses of Parliament. Enjoy a guided visit to Westminster Abbey which has played an integral part in the history of London and the UK for nearly 1000 years.

Enjoy a 2-course Lunch at a local pub or restaurant – no drinks included

Then enjoy a River Cruise: Glide from Tower Bridge to Embankment for a scenic view of London's iconic riverside landmarks. Enjoy a guided visit to the Tower of London, where history comes alive through tales of royalty, betrayal, and the Crown Jewels

Finish with the London Eye Experience: Cap off the afternoon with stunning panoramic views from Europe's tallest observation wheel.

After returning to the hotel, enjoy the remainder of the evening at your leisure. Consider a visit to Harrods or a stroll through Covent Garden.

Dinner at your hotel.

Overnight stay: London - Hotel: Crowne Plaza Kings Cross or SIMILAR



Day 4: WESLEY IN LONDON (B,L,D)

After breakfast at your hotel, dive into the spiritual heritage of John Wesley with a visit to: Wesley's Chapel and Home (entrance included) – Known as the "Mother Church of World Methodism," this site also includes the Museum of Methodism and John Wesley's House

Bunhill Fields Cemetery (entrance included) – Visit the burial sites of Susanna Wesley, John Bunyan, and Daniel Defoe

Aldersgate Street – Walk where John Wesley had his famous "heart-warming" conversion experience. Little Britain – Pass by the spot where Charles Wesley had his own conversion experience

You'll have a 2-course lunch at a local pub or restaurant – no drinks included

Continue with a panoramic drive through London: See Marble Arch, Hyde Park's Speakers' Corner, Trafalgar Square, and more. Stop at St. Paul's Cathedral (Admission Included), where John Wesley often worshipped and was deeply moved on the day of his conversion.

Dinner at your hotel.

Overnight stay: London - Hotel: Crowne Plaza Kings Cross or SIMILAR

Day 5: WINDSOR – BLENHEIM PALACE – BRISTOL (B,L,D)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Check out and drive to Windsor

You'll journey to visit Windsor Castle (admission included) - Windsor Castle is the oldest and largest occupied castle in the world. Founded by William the Conqueror in the 11th century, it has since been the home of 40 monarchs.

You'll have a 2-course lunch at a local pub or restaurant – no drinks included

Proceed to visit the Blenheim Palace (admission included) - Home to the 12th Duke and Duchess of Marlborough and birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill, Blenheim Palace is a true masterpiece of 18th-century Baroque architecture. Discover the beauty of this World Heritage Site amongst over 2000 acres of Capability Brown parkland and Formal Gardens

Check into your Hotel for dinner.

Day 6: BRISTOL, BATH & METHODIST HERITAGE (B,L,D)

After breakfast at your hotel, enjoy a day immersed in the legacy of Methodism and Georgian England:

The New Room- John Wesley's Chapel – The oldest purpose-built Methodist meeting house, beautifully preserved and historically rich. You'll be visiting the chapel downstairs which has a free entrance to the chapel itself. However, there is a charge for the museum located upstairs.

Entry to the museum is £7 for adults, £6 for concessions (students and seniors), £4 for children, and free for under-5

Charles Wesley's House (Admission Included) – Charles Wesley is widely regarded as the world's greatest hymn writer. He worked in Bristol from 1739 to 1787 and had his family home in Charles Street from 1749 to 1771. At first he lived at No 19 (a house that no longer exists) but then, in 1766, he moved to No 4 and, even after he had to move his family to London, he used this house on his visits to Bristol until at least 1782.

Lunch - 2-course lunch at a local pub or restaurant – no drinks included

Travel to Bath: Explore the elegant Georgian city. Visit the Roman Baths (Admission Included). Enjoy time in quaint shops and cafes

Dinner at your hotel or nearby.

Overnight stay: Bristol - Hotel: Hilton Garden Inn Bristol City Centre or SIMILAR

Day 7: LEGACY OF C.S. LEWIS & WESLEY (B,L,D)

Enjoy your breakfast at the hotel.

Drive to Oxford, upon arrival, enjoy a guided walking tour of Oxford: You will be viewing from the outside of the buildings for University College – Where C.S. Lewis studied, University Church of St. Mary the Virgin – A site significant to both the Oxford Martyrs and John Wesley.

Sheldonian Theatre and Christ Church College (Admissions Included) – Alma mater of the Wesley brothers and a stunning architectural site

Eagle and Child Pub – Famed meeting place of the "Inklings" literary group, including Lewis and Tolkien

Lunch - 2-course lunch at a local pub or restaurant – no drinks included

Ashmolean Museum (Admission included) – Explore treasures from Da Vinci to a Stradivarius violin

Drive to Bristol (approx. 2 hrs) for hotel check-in

Dinner at your hotel.

Overnight stay: Bristol - Hotel: Hilton Garden Inn Bristol City Centre or SIMILAR



Day 8: LONDON DEPARTURE (B)

Early morning departure from Bristol to London for your return flight to the USA.

Please be ready to leave by 7:00 AM.
