

# FOOTSTEPS OF PAUL GREECE TOUR

Apostle Paul's missionary journey is filled with stunning scenery and adventurous explorations where the New Testament church began.



## Day 1: ATHENS ARRIVAL / THESSALONIKI

Welcome to the magnificent country of Greece!

Today, you will arrive at Athens Airport then take the connecting flight to Thessaloniki to have your delightful dinner and overnight stay.





# Day 2: THESSALONIKI / PHILIPPI / KAVALA / THESSALONIKI

Good Morning! Have your delicious breakfast at the hotel. Get yourself ready because today, you will be visiting the city of Philippi where Paul delivered his first sermon in Europe, sowing the seeds of Christianity.

In here, Paul baptized a certain woman named Lydia, the first Christian convert in Europe. The Roman forum, completely excavated, is from after Paul's time.

Among the ruins, located on the rocky ledge above the town's main road is the prison where Paul and Silas were thrown.

You will continue your journey into the modern port city of Kavala, a city in northern Greece, the principal seaport of eastern Macedonia and the capital of Kavala regional unit.

It is situated on the Bay of Kavala, across from the island of Thasos and on the Egnatia motorway, a one-and-a-half-hour drive to Thessaloniki and a forty-minute drive to Drama and Xanthi and an ancient Neapolis, where Paul accompanied by Silas, Luke and Timothy, first set foot in Europe.

Enjoy your delightful dinner and overnight stay in Thessaloniki.

### Day 3: THESSALONIKI / KALAMBAKA

Good day! Rise and shine. Have your breakfast at the hotel.

You will be on a Thessaloniki City Tour wherein you will discover how Paul preached in Thessaloniki during the winters of 49-50 AD and wrote two epistles to the ancient Thessalonians.

See also the ramparts of the city, the triumphal Arch of Galerius or Kamara and the Rotunda are neighboring early 4th-century AD monuments in the city of Thessaloniki, in the region of Central Macedonia in northern Greece.

Straddling the Via Egnatia, a road constructed by the Romans in the 2nd century BC. It crossed Illyricum, Macedonia, and Thracia, running through territory that is now part of modern Albania, North Macedonia, Greece, and European Turkey as a continuation of the Via Appia, once a strategic artery of the Roman Empire.

You will then depart for Meteora Monasteries. The Meteora is a rock formation in central Greece hosting one of the largest and most precipitously built complexes of Eastern Orthodox monasteries, second in importance only to Mount Athos.

The six monasteries are built on immense natural pillars and hill-like rounded boulders that dominate the local area.

End your day with dinner and overnight stay in Kalambaka



#### Day 4: KALAMBAKA / DELPHI

Enjoy your hearty breakfast at the hotel. Today, you will visit Meteora Monasteries, among striking scenery, perched on top of huge rocks, which seem to be suspended in mid-air, stand ageless monasteries, where you can see exquisite specimens of Byzantine art.

Continue your tour to Delphi and have an awesome dinner and overnight stay.





You will relish your breakfast at the hotel for today you will be on a visit to Delphi, the center of the Ancient world – the "omphalos" (navel) of the earth – whose prestige extended far beyond the boundaries of the Hellenic world.

On the slopes of Mount Parnassus, in a landscape of unparalleled beauty and majesty, lie the ruins of the Sanctuary of Apollo Pythios.

Delphi in legend previously called Pytho (????), in ancient times was a sacred precinct that served as the seat of Pythia, the major oracle who was consulted about important decisions throughout the ancient classical world.

The oracle was international in character and also fostered sentiments of Greek nationality, even though the nation of Greece was centuries away from realization.

You will then visit and continue your journey to Athens and have a wonderful dinner and overnight stay

## Day 6: ATHENS / CORINTH / ATHENS

Rise and shine! Have your delightful breakfast at the hotel.

You will visit the Acropolis to see the ruins of the Parthenon, a temple that dominates the hill of the Acropolis at Athens. It was built in the mid-5th century BCE and dedicated to the Greek goddess Athena Parthenos ("Athena the Virgin").

The Erechtheion or Erechtheum is an ancient Greek temple on the north side of the Acropolis of Athens in Greece which was dedicated to both Athena and Poseidon

Then the Propylaea, propylea or propylaia is a monumental gateway. The prototypical Greek example is the propylaea that serves as the entrance to the Acropolis of Athens.

You shall also ascend Mars Hill and view the Agora, an ancient market place where Paul spoke to the ancient Athenians. You will also see the House of Parliament, the tomb of the Unknown Soldier, the Presidential Palace, Hadrian's Arch and the Panatheanic Stadium.

You will continue your tour to Ancient Corinth. Here under the shadow of the towering Acropolis. St. Paul preached and lived for two years. The vigorous and mostly Gentile Church he founded here in 50 AD caused him much grief and prompted him to write at least four letters to them.

Visit also the ruins of the ancient city where Paul worked with Aquila and Priscilla and see the remains of first century shops, the agora where Paul's trial by Gallio took place, the Fountain of Peirene, Temple of Apollo and the Bema.

You will then return to Athens and have a delicious dinner and overnight stay

# Booking Terms

Thank you for visiting Mission Travel Faith Tours website (the "Website") we are honored. The terms "MTT," "we" and "our" refers to Mission Travel Tours Inc., a Florida corporation, and a DMC tour operator registered with the State of Florida as a Seller of Travel Registration no. ST42780, which offers and operates along with our affiliate partners all trips listed herein.

#### 1. REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

A deposit of \$350 per person is required at the time of booking. We accept payment via credit card, wire transfer, or money order for your deposit. The balance is due 90 days prior to departure. If your reservation is made within 90 days of departure, the entire cost of the trip must be paid at the time of confirmation. To complete your reservation, you must sign a Traveler Information Form and an Acknowledgement of Risk, Release and Indemnity, prior to your date of travel with us. These will be sent to you in your booking confirmation email. These forms include additional terms and conditions of travel, including limitations of our obligations to you.

#### **CONFIRMATION PACKAGE**

Once payment is received and travel is confirmed we will send you detailed information on what to bring, how to prepare for your trip, travel directions, detailed itinerary, pre-and post-tour hotel information and Mission Travel Tours policies.

#### 2. CANCELLATION

All cancellations of confirmed reservations are subject to a \$350 per person administrative fee. Additionally, clients are subject to any cancellation fees assessed by the purveyors of services including hotels, rail, or airlines used in the itinerary. Cancellations 90 days or more prior to departure will receive a full refund minus the \$350 per person administrative fee. 60-89 days will be subject to loss of deposit (30% trip price). 30-59 days will be subject to loss of 50% of tour price. 29 days or less will be subject to 100% of tour price.

#### 3. INSURANCE

We recommend in all Deposit and Final Confirmation Packages travel insurance that offers you options to cover baggage, accident/ life, and/or trip cancellation. Trip cancellation insurance reimburses you for non-refundable air and land costs if you have to cancel a trip due to personal or family illness or accident. The insurance that we recommend also provides coverage for all preexisting conditions if you complete your insurance form and postmark it within seven calendar days of our receipt of your deposit. We highly recommend that you obtain this insurance.

We suggest Travel Guard International; there are two ways to purchase your insurance from Travel Guard. The fastest and easiest way is to purchase your insurance on-line by clicking the Travel Guard link after you have completed your reservation with Mission Travel Tours. The link will take you directly to the Travel Guard website, where in minutes you can be insured in full for your trip with us. Travel Guard will send you an insurance certificate. If you prefer for us to help you with this let us know and we can provide a Travel Guard application. Please

keep in mind that Travel Guard makes additional benefits available to you if you take out the insurance within 15' days of making your reservation with us

#### 4. PASSPORTS AND VISAS

The visa and passport requirements of countries to which we travel vary according to the nationality of each traveler and may change at any time for reasons beyond our control. Although we endeavor to provide you with accurate information about these requirements it remains the responsibility of each traveler to verify that he or she has the appropriate travel documents for his or her nationality. MTT is not liable for any expenses or costs arising from any traveler being prohibited from entering a country scheduled to be visited on a trip.

#### 5. BAGGAGE
